Who Needs to Register?

Anyone manufacturing pet treats in the state of West Virginia.

How?

Submit the appropriate application(s), registration fee and labels for each of your products 15 days before distribution occurs.

Applications found at wv.agriculture.gov

Annual Fees

Small Package Pet Food: 10 lbs. and under - \$75.00/product

Large Package Pet Food: Over 10 lbs. and Bulk - \$100.00/product.

Specialty Pet Food: Pets normally maintained in a cage or tank-\$40.00/ product.



Labeling Guidelines

Product name - Uniquely identifies type of feed

Brand name - Uniquely identifies distributor or registrant

Purpose Statement- Type of species intended for

Guaranteed Analysis:

Crude Protein (min) X%
Crude Fat (min) X%
Crude Fiber (max) X%
Moisture (max) X%

Ingredients - List all ingredients in descending order of predominance by weight

Feeding Directions - The front of label must state "This product is intended for intermittent or supplemental feeding only", "treat" or "snack"

Name and address of the manufacturer or distributor responsible for the product - City, state, and zip code

Quantity Statement - Net weight, volume, or count
