

RESOLUTION

Appointing and Confirming Members to the Building Commission

WHEREAS, the City of Ravenswood has appointed a Building Commission in conformity to W. Va. Code §8-33-3, (hereinafter "Commission"); and

WHEREAS, the Code requires the Common Council to form the Commission as follows: 1. The Commission shall consist of not less than three nor more than five members. 2. all members shall be appointed for a term of five years with one-fifth of the members being appointed for a term of one year, one-fifth of the members being appointed for a term of two years, one-fifth of the members being appointed for a term of three years, one-fifth of the members being appointed for a term of four years, and one-fifth of the members being appointed for a term of five years. 3. no more than two-thirds of the Commissioners shall be from the same political party 4. No Commissioners shall hold any other office (other than the office of the notary public, or be employed by the United States of America, the State of West Virginia, any county or political subdivision thereof, or any political party. 5. all Commissioners must be a residents of the City of Ravenswood;" and

WHEREAS, the Common Council requires that said Commission be established; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Ravenswood, hereby confirms the membership of the Building Commission, as follows:




