Opening Pyramid at 2011 National Tournament

Headquartered in Chippewa Lake, Ohio, the state's largest glacial lake, the Team is the only Division I Show Ski Team in Ohio. It was originally formed in 1969. The Team performed until the early 1970's.

The Team was reformed in 1997 with the objective to provide water skiing and ski shows to families who may not have access to boating and skiing expertise.

A commitment to competition brought the team the 2004 Division II National Championship and in 2010 the team placed 7th in Division I Nationals.

Doug & Rebecca Ribley became the 2006 & 2007 Division One National Champion Adagio Doubles Team.

In 2008, Karley VanDevere won the Willa Cook Award (Best Female Show Skier in the US). In 2009, Karley placed 2nd in the Nation in the Swivel Ski Competition.

COUNTY PARKS AND SHOW SKI RELATIONSHIPS

- **Lessons**: Free water ski and water safety learning opportunities
- **Entertainment**: Free, family-oriented, community entertainment (June thru August)
- Liability Insurance: CLWSST maintains its own liability insurance and lists the County Parks as an additional insured
- **Site Management/Upkeep**: County Parks Efficiency Partnership....CLWSST provides \$\$ and manpower to maintain the site location and accompanying park land (landscaping, lawn mowing, trash pick up, etc.)
- Economic Benefit: Significant economic benefit to Medina County through the creation of a <u>water sports destination</u>. Financial impact is realized from free shows, lessons, clinics, competitions, tournaments and the associated Hotel rooms, restaurant sales, etc. Warsaw, Indiana has calculated the economic impact of the small team in their market to be \$3,000,000 annually.
